Perceptions of Lib Institutions

- 2006-07 study
- 50 institution targeted: who used AFLI services before.
- Personality skills 80%:
 - Commitment, integrity, and attitude
 - Skills and competencies 65%

2006-07 study cont.

- 87% were happy with AFLI workshops
- 90% suggest they need more workshops
- 65% suggest improvement needed
- 70% suggest new subjects needed;
- 70% need to have it in their own countries (ladies)
- Gender attitude difference.
